If you or someone you know has experienced discrimination, harassment, or retaliation based on a protected status (e.g. age, disability, gender, race or ethnicity, religion), we encourage you to contact the Office for Civil Rights and Title IX for resources and assistance. This also includes experiences of sexual harassment, sexual misconduct, sexual exploitation, dating violence, domestic violence, stalking, and pregnancy and parenting discrimination.

The Office for Civil Rights & Title IX

Contact the Office to make a report, access supportive resources (e.g. academic allowances or Mutual No Contact Directives), or if you want to initiate a university investigation. If you request a meeting with this Office, you will not be obligated to pursue any action; the purpose of the meeting is to ensure you know your rights and options.
